EXT. TOWER BRIDGE, LONDON - AFTERNOON

WARWICK

MAVIS  
I'm sorry Warwick, but I'm looking for somebody a bit more brave. Somebody who faces his fears head on, instead of running away.

WARWICK  
I am such a person!

MAVIS frowns.

MAVIS  
I'm sorry, Warwick. I just don't feel excited by this relationship anymore.

MAVIS leaves. WARWICK sits down, looking defeated. Moments later, energetic police officer MADAME SALLY HUMBLE barges in looking flustered.

WARWICK  
Goodness, Sally! Is everything okay?

SALLY  
I'm afraid not.

WARWICK  
What is it? Don't keep me in suspense...

SALLY  
It's ... a cow ... I saw an evil cow care a bunch of piglets!

WARWICK  
Defenseless piglets?

SALLY  
Yes, defenseless piglets!

WARWICK

Bloomin' heck, Sally! We've got to do something.

SALLY

I agree, but I wouldn't know where to start.

WARWICK

You can start by telling me where this happened.

SALLY

I was...

SALLY fans herself and begins to wheeze.

WARWICK

Focus Sally, focus! Where did it happen?

SALLY

St Michael's Mount, Cornwall!  
That's right - St Michael's Mount,  
Cornwall!

WARWICK springs up and begins to run.

EXT. A ROAD - CONTINUOUS

WARWICK rushes along the street, followed by SALLY. They take a short cut through some back gardens, jumping fences along the way.

EXT. ST MICHAEL'S MOUNT, CORNWALL - SHORTLY AFTER

TRISTAN a brutal cow terrorises two piglets.

WARWICK, closely followed by SALLY, rushes towards TRISTAN, but suddenly stops in his tracks.

SALLY

What's the matter?

WARWICK

That's not just any old cow, that's Tristan!

SALLY

Who's Tristan?

WARWICK

Who's Tristan? Who's Tristan? Only  
the most brutal cow in the  
universe!

SALLY

Blinkin' knickers, Warwick! We're  
going to need some help if we're  
going to stop the most brutal cow  
in the universe!

WARWICK

You can say that again.

SALLY

Blinkin' knickers, Warwick! We're  
going to need some help if we're  
going to stop the most brutal cow  
in the universe!

WARWICK

I'm going to need feathers, lots of  
feathers.

Tristan turns and sees Warwick and Sally. He grins an evil  
grin.

TRISTAN

Warwick Bond, we meet again.

SALLY

You've met?

WARWICK

Yes. It was a long, long time  
ago...

EXT. A PARK - BACK IN TIME

A young WARWICK is sitting in a park listening to some sounds  
of the innocent music, when suddenly a dark shadow casts over  
him.

He looks up and sees TRISTAN. He takes off his headphones.

TRISTAN

Would you like some carrots?

WARWICK's eyes light up, but then he studies TRISTAN more  
closely, and looks uneasy.

WARWICK

I don't know, you look kind of brutal.

TRISTAN

Me? No. I'm not brutal. I'm the least brutal cow in the world.

WARWICK

Wait, you're a cow?

WARWICK runs away, screaming.

EXT. ST MICHAEL'S MOUNT, CORNWALL - PRESENT DAY

TRISTAN

You were a coward then, and you are a coward now.

SALLY

(To WARWICK) You ran away?

WARWICK

(To SALLY) I was a young child. What was I supposed to do?

WARWICK turns to TRISTAN.

TRISTAN

I may have run away from you then, but I won't run away this time!

WARWICK runs away.

He turns back and shouts.

WARWICK

I mean, I am running away, but I'll be back - with feathers.

TRISTAN

I'm not scared of you.

WARWICK

You should be.

INT. KINGS CROSS STATION, LONDON - LATER THAT DAY

WARWICK and SALLY walk around searching for something.

WARWICK

I feel sure I left my feathers  
somewhere around here.

SALLY

Are you sure? It does seem like an  
odd place to keep deadly feathers.

WARWICK

You know nothing Sally Humble.

SALLY

We've been searching for ages. I  
really don't think they're here.

Suddenly, TRISTAN appears, holding a pair of feathers.

TRISTAN

Looking for something?

SALLY

Crikey, Warwick, he's got your  
feathers.

WARWICK

Tell me something I don't already  
know!

SALLY

The earth's circumference at the  
equator is about 40,075 km.

WARWICK

I know that already!

SALLY

general calamity.

TRISTAN

(appalled) Dude!

While TRISTAN is looking at SALLY with disgust, WARWICK lunges forward and grabs his deadly feathers. He wields them, triumphantly.

WARWICK

Prepare to die, you brutal rump  
roast!

TRISTAN

No please! All I did was care a  
bunch of piglets!

MAVIS enters, unseen by any of the others.

WARWICK

I cannot tolerate that kind of behaviour! Those piglets were defenceless! Well now they have a defender - and that's me! Warwick Bond defender of innocent piglets.

TRISTAN

Don't hurt me! Please!

WARWICK

Give me one good reason why I shouldn't use these feathers on you right away!

TRISTAN

Because Warwick, I am your father.

WARWICK looks stunned for a few moments, but then collects himself.

WARWICK

No you're not!

TRISTAN

Ah well, it had to be worth a try.

TRISTAN tries to grab the feathers but WARWICK dodges out of the way.

WARWICK

Who's the daddy now? Huh? Huh?

Unexpectedly, TRISTAN slumps to the ground.

SALLY

Did he just faint?

WARWICK

I think so. Well that's disappointing. I was rather hoping for a more dramatic conclusion, involving my deadly feathers.

WARWICK crouches over TRISTAN's body.

SALLY

Be careful, Warwick. It could be a trick.

WARWICK

No, it's not a trick. It appears that... It would seem... Tristan is dead!

SALLY

What?

WARWICK

Yes, it appears that I scared him  
to death.

SALLY claps her hands.

SALLY

So your feathers did save the day,  
after all.

MAVIS steps forward.

MAVIS

Is it true? Did you kill the brutal  
cow?

WARWICK

Mavis how long have you been...?

MAVIS puts her arm around WARWICK.

MAVIS

Long enough.

WARWICK

Then you saw it for yourself. I  
killed Tristan.

MAVIS

Then the piglets are safe?

WARWICK

It does seem that way!

A crowd of vulnerable piglets enter, looking relieved.

MAVIS

You are their hero.

The piglets bow to WARWICK.

WARWICK

There is no need to bow to me. I  
seek no worship. The knowledge that  
Tristan will never care for piglets  
ever again, is enough for me.

MAVIS

You are humble as well as brave!

One of the piglets passes WARWICK a gentle free love



MAVIS (CONT'D)

I think they want you to have it,  
as a symbol of their gratitude.

WARWICK

I couldn't possibly.

(beat)

Well, if you insist.

WARWICK takes the free love.

WARWICK (CONT'D)

Thank you.

The piglets bow their heads once more, and leave.

WARWICK turns to MAVIS.

WARWICK (CONT'D)

Does this mean you want me back?

MAVIS

Oh, Warwick, of course I want you  
back!

WARWICK smiles for a few seconds, but then looks defiant.

WARWICK

Well you can't have me.

MAVIS

WHAT?

WARWICK

You had no faith in me. You had to  
see my scare a cow to death before  
you would believe in me. I don't  
want a lover like that.

MAVIS

But...

WARWICK

Please leave. I want to spend time  
with the one person who stayed with  
me through thick and thin - my best  
friend, Sally.

SALLY grins.

MAVIS

But...

SALLY  
You heard the gentleman. Now be off  
with you. Skidaddle! Shoo!

MAVIS  
Warwick?

WARWICK  
I'm sorry Mavis, but I think you  
should skidaddle.

MAVIS leaves.

SALLY turns to WARWICK.

SALLY  
Did you mean that? You know ...  
that I'm your best friend?

WARWICK  
Of course you are!

The two walk off arm in arm.

Suddenly SALLY stops.

SALLY  
When I said general calamity, you  
know I was just trying to distract  
the cow don't you?
